Buyer agrees to pay the purchase price of _____ any sales tax or transportation costs associated with the delivery of that puppy. A deposit \$ _____ must be paid to hold the above dog and is **Non-Refundable** except in the event the puppy should have any **genetic or life threatening** health issues while in the care of the breeder. If the puppy has any **genetic/life threatening** health issues while in the care of the breeder, the buyer may have the choice of another puppy of equal purchase price or may choose to have the deposit refunded. Payment is to be made in full and cleared before the puppy leaves the premises. If the buyer buys a puppy with a known issue such as but not limited to a heart murmur, subluxating patella, ect.. Then those issues and treatment of the known issue are not covered by this guarantee. Any known issues will be listed here. _____

Breeder agrees to transfer all rights, privileges and responsibilities associated with the ownership of the puppy to the purchaser after 8 weeks of age. If the puppy is to be transported by a transportation company per USDA guidelines the puppy must be 2 pounds or 12 weeks of age whichever comes first. Breeder agrees to provide the purchaser with AKC Registration applications(If applicable), proper vaccinations/deworming history record, and the proper veterinary health report of the puppy.

The puppy listed above will have an exam by a licenced veterinarian prior to the transfer/Pick up date of _____. Immediately after the exam the breeder will contact the buyer with the results of the exam. In some cases the puppy may have had a recent exam with a vet.

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Health Guarantee

Puppy will be delivered or picked up on _____. Once the buyer takes possession of the puppy the buyer agrees to have the puppy examined by their licensed veterinarian within 72 hours of the puppy arriving into the buyer's possession at the buyers expense. The buyer agrees to provide the breeder with a copy of the veterinarian health report within 72 hours or the health guarantee portion of the contract will be voided.

In the event of any genetic disorder within the puppy's first 12 months of life which is sufficiently serious in the opinion of at least TWO qualified veterinarians, one of whom will be selected by the breeder, to deem the puppy unsuitable as a companion pet or to warrant euthanasia of the puppy the breeder agrees to:

- Replace the puppy with one of equivalent purchase price within 18 months or at breeder option.
- Refund the original purchase price, minus shipping and vet costs of the above listed puppy.

In either of these cases the puppy must be relinquished to the breeder. Return shipping, veterinary, and testing expenses associated with the replacement of the puppy are the responsibility of the buyer.

Buyer: Must, in any cases, willingly and openly provide documentation to the tests performed, supporting veterinary reports, and veterinarian contact information to the breeder. Buyer understands that allowing the puppy to become overweight, over vaccinated, and failure to provide the puppy with adequate diet, exercise, proper veterinary care, and protection from the hazards to health and development of the puppy will deem the health guarantee portion of the contract VOIDED.

The Breeder's guarantee does NOT cover any liability for any injury, or illness caused by stress induced hypoglycemia, canine influenza, pneumonia, parasites internal or external, ringworm, coccidiosis, giardia, hepatitis, other diseases/illnesses/viruses, or mites after leaving our care. There are all types of parasites that lie dormant and that can be brought on by stress or change of environment due to allergies etc., and there is no way to predict how a pup will cope with the change. This is why the buyer agrees to not change the puppy's dog food for at least 1 week after pickup as to not stress the puppy more than necessary. Also, there is no guarantee against any diseases contracted after leaving premises. We do our best to provide a clean, healthy, safe environment and to ensure that the buyer is getting a healthy pup.

Buyer agrees to maintain the puppy in a humane environment with shelter, a healthy diet, fresh water exercise, human interaction, properly train and care for the puppy, and provide proper and necessary veterinarian care. Breeder encourages the buyer to provide appropriate opportunities for socialization with children, other dogs, and strangers. If at any point in the puppy's life the buyer is no longer able to care for the puppy, the puppy must be returned to the breeder or properly rehomed. Breeder is not required to compensate the buyer for the puppy's expenses or purchase price when the puppy is returned.
